City Council Meeting  
April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021, 7:00 P.M.**

**Call to Order**

President of the Council Brian Kirkpatrick called the meeting to order with Council Members Brian Crapson, Jamie Burke, and Cory Scott, in attendance. Also in attendance were City Clerk Saralyn Boyd, City Treasurer Samantha Guy, City Superintendent Craig Kirkpatrick, and City Attorney Timothy Fielder. **Approval of Agenda**
