Call to Order

Mayor Karen Crapson called the meeting to order with Council Members Jamie Burke, Brian Crapson, and Joshua Sturm, in attendance. Approval of Agenda

Librarian's Report

Sierra brought in the estimate of the heat and air unit for the Community Center. The estimate was from CDL for \$4,820.00. This estimated amount would be split 50/50 between the Community Center and the City. Brian Crapson made the motion for the city to cover ½ the cost at \$2,410.00. Jamie Burke seconded the motion. All were in favor.
